Urolithiasis is one of the major diseases of the urinary tract and is a major source of morbidity. Urolithiasis is the formation of mineral deposits within the urine, occasionally observed in the renal pelvis and/or the urinary bladder, more frequently the latter. Urolithiasis is a potential emergency often resulting in acute abdominal, low back, flank or groin pain. In conventional medical system, pain killer are used for symptomatic management.
